

Getting System Information Customization

The Hard Way

- `lspci`
- `uname -a`
- `cat /etc/issue`
- `cat /proc/cpuinfo`

The Easy Way

- Use neofetch
- `sudo apt-get install neofetch`
- (alt: `sudo apt install neofetch`)

Bonus

Make neofetch appear whenever terminal is opened:

- Nautilus -> Home directory
- ctrl-h to show hidden files
- edit .bashrc: nano .bashrc -> scroll to end -> add "neofetch" (without the quotes)

Another Bonus

- Make terminal transparent
 - Preferences -> Profile -> Colors

Customizing GNOME

- Install GNOME Tweaks
- Install GNOME shell extensions
 - In Web browser: extensions.gnome.org
 - Click to allow integration into Firefox
 - My favorites: Magic Lamp, ArcMenu
